GOVERNOR'S MAY BUDGET REVISE

Recently Governor Brown released his May budget revision and there is some good news for education funding. The revised budget is an attempt to craft a state budget that is balanced between cuts and increased revenue. There is an increase in Proposition 98 funding of three billions (\$3 billion) as compared with the January proposal. This is news that could not have come at a better time for layoff rescissions in SCUSD. School Services at their recent workshop told all districts to add an additional three hundred forty nine dollars (\$349) per student ADA back into their budgets in place of the negative nineteen dollars (-\$19) from January's budget proposal. We are hoping for a mass of rescissions in the days to come. The hope is that this news will result in many of our laid off members being called back. Please stay tuned for more news on this topic as things develop at the state and district level.

CONTRACT

The current contract between SCTA and the district does not expire until June 30, 2012. We at SCTA understand there are quite a few rumors of possible changes- *BUT*- that is all they are – *RUMORS*. Yes this includes and let us be very clear, *No changes to class size*.
