RE: New Joseph Bonnheim Charter School

Dear Superintendent Aguilar,

This is in follow up to the COVID testing being run weekly at New Joseph Bonnheim Charter School in response to a cluster of 23 positives that were identified on September 2, 2021. Test results for the weekly testing are summarized below:

- Tests run on September 3, had zero positives out of 153 tests run
- Tests run on September 8, had 2 positives out of 185 tests run.
- Tests run on September 15, had zero positives out of 203 tests run.
- Tests run on September 22, showed 8 positives out of 208 tests run.

Given the 8 positives identified from last week's run, we are requiring that the weekly testing continue for an additional two weeks. We also request the school staff continue to work with the Public Health Schools Team to conduct contact tracing related to the new identified cases. The weekly testing has helped to monitor the situation and ensure timely identification of any new positives to prevent on campus transmission.

Thank you and the school administration for the prompt reporting of these results and for all the prevention protocols that have been instituted. Please let me know if you have any further questions.
